

8 Oct 25 From Thick to Thin Materials List

Cover for 6ft table (newspaper, plastic etc) apron, kitchen sponge with scourer, pencil, rubber, scrap paper, kitchen roll, scissors

Either acrylic or water colour TUBES. Bring a selection (at least one sky colour eg prussian, one dark eg burnt number, black, indigo ; one bright eg red, raw sienna and white)

For watercolours ideally white gouache which is thicker.

Useful colours generally. Cadmium lemon, cad yellow, prussian blue, ultramarine, burnt umber, raw sienna, white, cad red, alizarin crimson.

300gram/140lb rough water colour paper will be necessary in a3 size. Some cheaper may be ok for exercises.

A board slightly bigger than paper(MDF, hardboard etc or see Home Direct's art one with handle and clips. DIY white masking

A big white plastic palette that will hold big washes. 4 paper cups or similar that will pour. Water spray.

Big soft brushes e.g a hake (1 inch approx £3) or size 12 upwards round. A smaller detail brush ideally a rigger (approx £3 Hobbycraft)

Credit card or scraper.
