MATERIALS PALLETTE TO TROWEL

From home

Waterproof table cover [6ft]/newspapers Apron/Overall, old shirt is ideal! Mask,scissors 2 large water pots [eg large yougurt] Pencil and ruler Kitchen sponge with scourer side Kitchen roll. Masking tape Any plastering/spreading type tools from the shed

Specifically...

A palette-white crock/plastic/paper plate. Or from art shop BIG plastic Palette . [we need to hold pools of paint]. A tear off palette is best [cheapest in bargain shops where found] **Paints-ACRYLICS**

Artists or students quality eg pebeo/system 3 daler rowney/Hobbycrafts own. Some bargain ones and sets are ok [but u have to interpret colours below].

I suggest specifically these,Ultramarine blue, Prussian blue, White [ideally titanium],Raw sienna, lemon yellow, cadmium yellow, cadmium red, alizarin crimson[avoid the pebeo one], burnt umber , paynes grey

Ground-

Ideally a stretched canvas approx a3 size[twice size of a letter] and proportions. Most bargain shops sell these for £3ish eg the Home bargains shop in Teignmouth high street.

Or a3 pieces of rough water colour paper at least 200gram/140lb in weight. You will need a board just larger and cream masking tape to fix.

Scrap thick paper or board for practice pieces eg mounting or backs of pads Spare paper or canvas a4 to a3 in case we have time for a second pic.

Brushes etc

Sometimes we need flat areas too..,stiff, bristle, long handled brush [sets of 6 varied from bargain shops \pounds 1-1.50 are ideal] Or bring what you have

Palette knife [sets of reasonable plastic or metal ones at the Works or fancier individual ones at Hobbycraft and Totnes fri market].
