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Course Content

Module 1 | Talking about the Past (*Weeks 1–2*)

Learn how to talk about holidays, weekends and memorable experiences. You'll practise asking and answering questions about past events and become more confident telling simple stories in Spanish.

Module 2 | Home, Family & Everyday Life (*Weeks 3–4*)

Expand your vocabulary to describe your home, introduce your family and talk about the people who are important to you. A practical module designed to help you have more natural, personal conversations.

Module 3 | Speak More Naturally (*Week 5*)

Discover the everyday expressions that Spanish speakers use to keep conversations flowing. Learn how to express your opinions, link your ideas together and sound more confident when speaking.

Module 4 | Making Plans & Talking about the Weather (*Weeks 6–8*)

Learn how to talk about future plans, arrange social activities and discuss holidays using everyday Spanish. You'll also explore weather vocabulary and learn how to understand and talk about weather forecasts—one of the most useful conversation topics in daily life.

Module 5 | Childhood, Memories & Life Stories (*Weeks 9–11*)

Take your Spanish to the next level by talking about your childhood, sharing memories and describing how life used to be. This module will help you tell richer, more interesting stories about yourself and your experiences.

Module 6 | Spanish in Action (*Weeks 12–13*)

Put everything you've learned into practice through enjoyable conversation activities, role plays and real-life scenarios. By the end of the course, you'll feel more confident communicating in Spanish about your past, present and future.

By the end of the course you will be able to:

- Talk confidently about past experiences and memorable events.
- Describe your home, family and everyday life.
- Express your opinions and keep conversations flowing more naturally.
- Make plans, invitations and talk about future activities.
- Understand and discuss simple weather forecasts.
- Share memories and describe life in the past.
- Communicate with greater confidence in a wide range of everyday situations.

This course is suitable for adult learners who have completed an introductory Spanish course (A1) or have an equivalent level of knowledge and are ready to progress towards A2. It is particularly suitable for students who would like to improve their speaking skills while continuing to develop their grammar and vocabulary in a practical, communicative way.
